CODE OF CONDUCT

It is good practice for schools to agree a code of conduct with parents and students before students participate in educational visits. Acceptance of a code will provide all parties with the necessary authority to carry out their responsibilities.

All students should:

- Avoid behaviour that may inconvenience others
- Be considerate to, and of, others at all times
- Respect all requests by school staff and accompanying adults
- Behave at all times in a manner that reflects positively on themselves, the party and the school
- Consult with school staff if in doubt about any issues

Code of Conduct for Parents: We fully appreciate the ongoing and valuable parental support at sporting fixtures and events throughout the year. This code of conduct is a gentle reminder of the sporting ethos, and our joint responsibility to uphold the core principles in terms of our attitude and behaviour before, during and after each sporting event. Match day is inevitably an exciting occasion for all, but it can also be a highly charged affair with emotions running out of control when the stakes appear to be high. At Bromsgrove our aim is to provide a sports programme that is based on positive experiences. We believe in the development of the whole child, the fostering of an 'active life' philosophy and the promotion of a lifetime investment in sport and physical activity. This sporting ethos celebrates enjoyment, equality of access, breadth of participation and excellence both on and off the field. In order for our ethos to be upheld and our sports programme to be truly successful, it takes the cooperation of all involved; players, coaches, staff, spectators and parents.

Parents as role models: Parents and guardians have a responsibility to help make sure their child gets the most out of their playing experience. Parental support should always include positive reinforcement of both your child's performance and of their efforts. This is essential at an early age, to encourage strong self- esteem and a healthy development in general. Parents should aim to be positive role models, including the display of sportsmanship and the notion of fair play and by avoiding negativity of any kind. It is not acceptable for anyone to ridicule or chastise their child, or others, for making a mistake or for losing a game. Parents should encourage children to play according to the rules at all times.

PARKING

Fixtures at Bromsgrove Senior School Campus: all visiting parents should use postcode **B61 7HP** to locate the main car park by our sports hall which is within walking distance of all pitches and venues.

Fixtures at Bromsgrove Prep School Campus: all visiting parents should use postcode **B60 2AE**. to locate the prep school car park which is within walking distance of all Prep pitches and venues.

All Team transport coaches, whether the fixture is at our Senior or Prep site should park at the main car park at Senior School using postcode **B61 7HP**. Drivers will be greeted by a member of our Gatehouse team who will direct you to specific parking within the car park.

Fixtures at Winterfold House School Campus: all visiting schools and parents should use the postcode **DY10 4PW** to locate the main car park which is within easy walking distance of all pitches and venues.

DOGS At Bromsgrove School we have a strict no dog policy. Please not bring any dogs on to the site; you will be asked to remove any dogs that are brought onto the campus. This policy is to ensure the health and safety of students, staff and visitors.

MEDICAL SUPPORT Medical provision is provided across all fixtures. If any pupil requires further medical support, they will be taken to our physio room which is located below the Hospitality Suite, opposite the netball courts. Our medical teams will treat pupils where appropriate and offer advice and guidance to parents if required.

MEET & GREET FOR TEAMS A member of Bromsgrove School staff will be waiting to meet you on arrival. They will direct you and your pupils to the appropriate changing rooms and will be happy to answer any further questions on the day's fixture.

AFTER MATCH TEAS FOR PLAYERS AND STAFF All pupils will be guided to the School Dining Hall where after match teas are available. Once finished, players will be able to meet their parents at the Hospitality Suite or return to their coach. Staff will be hosted in the Senior School Staff Centre and will be guided there by their opposite staff member.


