SCHOOL UNIFORM AND THE SCHOOL SHOP

School uniform can be purchased from our online retailer: www.schoolblazer.com

Essential and recommended items of uniform are listed on the following pages.

Schoolblazer are an online retailer – allowing parents to order anytime and from anywhere, at their convenience.

Delivery is via DPD with a typical turn-around of 1-2 days, and a firm promise of delivery within 3 working days.

Urgent orders can be shipped within 24 hours using their Fasttrack service. DPD send a text message to confirm a delivery window, and delivery can be rearranged if not convenient. **Boarding pupils** are advised to order garments to be delivered to School, please include your child's name and House on the order.

The Schoolblazer website has an “intelligent sizing system” helping ensure that garments fit first time. On registration you will be asked to input your child's sizes and the system will suggest the appropriate fit. The website guides you through items required as uniform, and indicates whether items are compulsory or optional.

Returns to Schoolblazer (from the UK) are free of charge via the Post Office and they operate a 120 day return policy. Boarders should order items to be delivered to the School address, and if returns are necessary, House staff will help pupils with this.

Any queries about orders should be sent direct to Schoolblazer, using the contact details on their website.

Sports Kit and Stationery Supplies

Our School Shop, based on the Senior School campus, sells all the necessary sports kit and stationery. Essential and recommended items are included on the lists on the following pages.

The School Shop stocks a wide range of stationery, pens, pencils, books and files that pupils will need for lessons. They also sell a small range of essential toiletries.

Each pupil is provided with a School Shop card which allows them to purchase additional sports kit and stationery. This card must be signed and presented when making a purchase. Any items purchased using the card will be billed at the end of each term.

GIRLS' DRESS CODE SUMMARY

FOURTH AND FIFTH FORM (Years 9, 10 & 11)

BLAZER:	School regulation navy blue
SKIRT:	School regulation ^skirt, to be worn mid-calf, unaltered, and as sold by the uniform supplier
TROUSERS:	School regulation tartan ^trousers, to sit on the back of the shoe.
<i>^Girls have the choice of wearing a skirt or trousers, many do have both, but this is not essential and you may purchase whichever is your preference.</i>	
SHIRT:	Winter – School white shirt, fully tucked in, top button always fastened, with tie Summer – School white revere-neck blouse, fully tucked in, no tie
TIE:	School or House tie
PULLOVER:	School-crested regulation navy blue V-neck pullover
TIGHTS:	Unpatterned natural or navy blue (not black) tights or knee length navy socks
SHOES:	Smart and formal plain black leather flat shoes (no patent, suede or fabric), ballet, boot or trainer styles are not acceptable
OVERCOAT:	School regulation overcoat, or plain tailored coat in navy blue worn with the School blazer
ACCESSORIES:	School rucksack/laptop bag or plain black bag/laptop bag (no logos) School maroon umbrella School scarf
HAIR:	Natural colour – no extremes of colour, cut or style, tied back fully, neatly and off the face. Hair bobbles and bands in navy blue or maroon. Religious head coverings may be navy blue, maroon, black or white.
JEWELLERY:	A watch One set of small stud earrings, to be worn at the bottom of the earlobe (no other piercings) No necklaces, bracelets or rings One discreet item of religious jewellery may be worn at the discretion of the School. Pupils wishing to do so should seek prior approval from their Houseparent or a member of the Senior Pastoral Team.
MAKE-UP:	No make-up and only clear nail varnish is permitted. No false eyelashes or false nails.
SPORTS KIT:	Only School sports kit may be worn on campus (see list below)

BLAZER:	School regulation - navy blue
TROUSERS:	School regulation - charcoal grey
SHIRT:	Winter – School white long-sleeved shirt Summer – School short-sleeved white shirt, tucked in, top button always fastened, with tie
TIE:	School or House tie
PULLOVER:	School-crested regulation navy blue V-neck pullover
SHOES:	Smart plain black leather lace-up shoes (no patent, suede or fabric) boot or trainer styles are not acceptable
SOCKS:	Dark grey
OVERCOAT:	School regulation overcoat or plain tailored coat in navy blue, worn with the School blazer

SIXTH FORM UNIFORM

The following pages list our Dress Code for the Sixth Form. Sixth Formers are expected to support the School by wearing uniform smartly, and in the spirit of the business environment.

Parents/Guardians are asked to ensure that clothes/items conform to the specifics noted on the list. We ask that you adhere to these guidelines, as any items deemed unsuitable for School wear will need to be replaced. If you have any queries about Sixth Form uniform, please contact either the Senior Master or Senior Mistress, your child's Houseparent or the Deputy Headmaster Pastoral.

All items of clothing must be clearly named, boarders should include the initials of their House after their name. Name tapes and labelling of clothes can be ordered on the Schoolblazer site, the School Shop can also pre-order name tapes.

The School's online retailer, Schoolblazer, stocks a number of styles of suits for Sixth Form boys and girls, alternatively you may visit one of the classic UK retailers such as Marks & Spencers or Next or John Lewis. School ties for Sixth Form Boys can be purchased in the School Shop or are available from Schoolblazer.



DRESS CODE SUMMARY - SIXTH FORM GIRLS

TAILORED SUIT:	Plain dark grey, navy blue or black No bold stripes or checks Jacket and skirt/trousers of matching material and colour Skirt to sit on or below the knee (not tight) Trousers of a smart cut; not skinny, bootleg or jeans-style, to sit on the back of the shoe
BLOUSE:	Plain cotton collared 'shirt' style with buttons in white or light pastel shade (no dark colours) of an appropriate (not tight) fit, always tucked in
PULLOVER:	Plain V-neck pullover in black, dark grey, navy blue or maroon
HOSIERY:	Unpatterned natural, black or navy blue tights Natural, black or navy blue pop socks to be worn with trousers
SHOES:	Smart plain black or patent leather (no suede or fabric) Heels not more than 3cms in height (no stiletto heels), ballet boot and trainer styles are not permitted
OVERCOAT:	School coat or plain tailored coat in navy blue, black or dark grey (worn over suit)
SPORTS KIT:	Only School sports kit may be worn on campus
ACCESSORIES:	School rucksack/laptop bag or plain black bag (no logos) School umbrella School scarf
HAIR:	Natural colour – no extremes of colour, cut or style. Bobbles in navy blue, maroon, black or brown. Religious head coverings may be in navy blue, maroon, black or white.
JEWELLERY:	A watch One discreet ring, bracelet and necklace may be worn One set of small, unobtrusive earrings to be worn at the bottom of the earlobe (no other piercings)
MAKE-UP:	Subtle make-up and nail varnish, if worn

Any concerns or requests can be discussed with your Houseparent / Senior Mistress or Deputy Headmaster Pastoral.

SPORTS KIT

All Sixth Formers need the following, which are available from the School Shop:

- School tracksuit bottoms
- School white polo shirt

If pupils are selected for School teams, they may need to purchase kit and a School games holdall as advised by the PE department.

COMMEMORATION

Commemoration outfits should be smart, formal, respectful, and appropriate for Church. Please think smart, formal, respectful and appropriate for Church. The outfit should be a skirt/dress/trouser suit or a jacket and co-ordinating skirt/dress/trousers. Off-the shoulder or strapless dresses/tops are not acceptable. Skirts and dresses should sit on or below the knee. Pashminas or cardigans are not appropriate. As this is a formal occasion, a hat or fascinator is allowed. Equally, this is an occasion on which some of our international students choose to wear their national dress, which is an entirely appropriate option. The day involves a good deal of walking to different venues, so please make sure that shoes are of a comfortable height. Trainers or flip-flop styles are not appropriate. If you have any queries, would like to see examples of appropriate styles or would like to check the suitability of your outfit, please email the Senior Mistress, Miss Leech

DRESS CODE SUMMARY - SIXTH FORM BOYS

TAILORED SUIT:	Plain dark grey, navy blue or black No bold stripes or checks Trousers of a smart cut, not skinny, bootleg or jeans-style, to sit on the back of the shoe Alternatively, sports jacket and dark grey/black trousers
SHIRT:	Plain white or light pastel shade (no dark colours) Tucked in, top button always fastened, with tie
TIE:	School or House tie (School ties are available from Schoolblazer.com or the School Shop)
PULLOVER:	Plain v-neck pullover in black, dark grey, navy blue or maroon
SHOES:	Plain black leather (no suede, patent or fabric). Boot and trainer styles are not acceptable
SOCKS:	Plain dark or formal coloured striped/patterned socks
OVERCOAT:	School coat or plain tailored coat in navy blue, black or dark grey (to be worn over suit)
SPORTS KIT:	Only School sports kit may be worn on campus, (see list below)
ACCESSORIES:	School rucksack/laptop bag or plain black bag/laptop bag (no logos) School umbrella School scarf
HAIR:	Natural colour – no extremes of colour, cut or style. Hair should be neat, covering neither the collar nor eyes. No part of the hairstyle to be very closely cropped or shaved. Clean shaven unless facial hair is agreed with Senior Pastoral Leaders for religious observation. Religious head coverings may be navy blue, maroon, black, or white
JEWELLERY:	A watch, one discreet ring, a bracelet and a necklace can be worn

Any concerns or requests can be discussed with your Houseparent / Senior Master or Deputy Headmaster Pastoral

SPORTS KIT

All Sixth Formers need the following, which are available from the School Shop:

If pupils are selected for School teams, they may need to purchase kit and a School games holdall as advised by the PE department.

COMMEMORATION

Boys should wear a formal tailored dark grey, navy blue or black suit in plain material or with a faint pin stripe/check. Light coloured suits are not acceptable. Shirts should be of a plain white or pastel shade (no dark colours). A School or House tie and a School boater or School Cap (if applicable) should be worn. Some of our international students choose to wear their National dress for this occasion, which is an entirely appropriate option. If you have any queries, please email the Senior Master, Mr Matthews.

BOARDERS' KIT LIST - all years

Boarding bedrooms must be kept clean and tidy at all times. Some boarders purchase clothing online, but they must ensure that they have adequate space in their bedrooms to accommodate these purchases. If possessions accumulate, items may be placed in storage off-site or couriered home. Storage in the rooms is adequate, and includes a wardrobe and a set of drawers. Each pupil has lockable storage for mobile phones/laptop etc.

The boarders' kit list is clear, and we request pupils adhere to it. All items of clothing brought to School must be clearly labelled with name and House initials. Labels can be purchased from the School Shop, or on www.schoolblazer.com.

We ask that boarders bring only a sensible amount of luggage due to limited storage space. Boarders may purchase clothing online, but they must ensure that they have adequate space in their bedrooms to accommodate these purchases. If possessions accumulate, items may be placed in storage off-site or couriered home.

Casual and Personal Clothes (for example)

- Appropriate underwear and nightwear (including dressing gown)
- 4 pairs of casual shoes (including one pair of trainers for games/PE)
- 4 pairs of casual bottoms (jeans, trousers, shorts, skirts etc)
- 4 casual tops (t-shirts, shirts etc)
- 1 coat or jacket
- 3 items of warmer outerwear (hoodies, jumpers, fleece etc)

Electrical Items

Many electrical items are not allowed in rooms for health and safety reasons. As such, electrical items should be restricted to the following:

- Laptop and/or tablet
- Hairdryer/straighteners
- Mobile phone and charger

Extension cables are *not* allowed to be used in boarding rooms. Cooking equipment and kettles are strictly forbidden.

Toiletries

Toiletries can be purchased in the local town centre.

Bedding

Two sets of bedding for a single bed.

Bedding packs can be pre-ordered from the School Shop; the packs, include two pillows, a duvet, duvet cover and pillow cases, plus a bath towel and a hand towel. Pre-ordered bedding will have name tapes sewn in, and will be delivered to the pupil's House prior to arrival. The bedding pack and name tapes should be paid for on arrival. You can either bring, or purchase, additional bed linen from local shops on arrival (for when a set is in the laundry).

Each pupil needs two named bath towels, if necessary these can be purchased on arrival.

Food

A small amount of snack food may be stored in boarding rooms. Tuck boxes for this purpose are provided in the School Shop. Food should only be stored in these boxes. Perishable items must not be stored in rooms, and will be removed for health and safety reasons. Fridges are available for the storage of small amounts of fresh food.

Furniture, Storage and Additional Items

All necessary furniture, fixtures and fittings are provided by the School. Please do not bring any additional items. All rooms have to be completely stripped at the end of each term to allow domestic staff to thoroughly clean.

When leaving at the end of the Upper Sixth, pupils must take all their belongings with them, or organise an external storage company.
