RESULTS 2026

In recent weeks, we have been celebrating the excellent results achieved by Bromsgrove pupils in their GCSE, A level, and IB examinations.

Our IB students achieved an average of 38.5 points, the lowest IB score here was above the world average; the highest was an amazing 45/45 – achieved by less than 1% of IB students anywhere and all this helped to place Bromsgrove amongst the highest-performing IB schools in the world.

Overall, last year's leavers achieved the equivalent of 60% A* and A grades at A level, while the average GCSE grade (across nearly 2,000 results) was a grade 7.

A quarter of the 227 students who left us in the summer are about to begin courses at universities ranked among the world's top 50, and three quarters of those who will be studying in the UK will be doing so at Russell Group universities. Indeed, 60% of those progressing to UK universities will be taking up places at Bath, Birmingham, Durham, Exeter, King's College London, Manchester, Nottingham, UCL and Warwick later this month, while 83% secured places at their first-choice university.
