2012

Overall, 170 pupils sat 598 A levels and achieved a remarkable 87.3% A* to B grades with 61% at A* and A, and a quarter at A*. Close to one half of the pupil body achieved three or more As and A*s, with over 20% achieving four or more A and A* grades. All Oxford and Cambridge candidates achieved their offers. The average UCAS point tariff at A level was 440, which is equivalent to A*, A, A at A level with a further A grade in an AS level. (The average Bromsgrove International Bacculaureate tariff was in excess of 500 UCAS points).

Headmaster Chris Edwards said: "To secure these sensational averages in a year when many bright pupils had actually opted for the International Bacculaureate and achieved equally stunning outcomes a month earlier is nothing less than remarkable. Staff, pupils and parents should be bursting with pride. And we are doing this in the subjects that really matter. For example: eighty two pupils sat A level Maths with almost half achieving A* and over three quarters getting at least an A. These young men and women will make a difference in and to the future."
